Deposit ELARF money as KPERS

On **Tuesday, April 15**, Special Education State Aid and 4th quarter KPERS payment (including ELARF money - see note) will deposit. State aid payment amounts for each LEA are available online - [Payment Information](#).

Note: The allocation of April KPERS State Aid includes money from the **Expanded Lottery Act Revenue Fund (ELARF)**, which should be deposited in the Code 51-KPERS fund and treated as KPERS State Aid. *ELARF funds will not need to be tracked separately.*

The **KPERS payment** is required to be deposited in the KPERS Special Retirement Contribution Fund as a receipt and recorded as an expenditure broken out by function code as outlined in Code 51 of the USD budget. Kansas law requires school districts to record this as a revenue and an expenditure. KPERS will withdraw these funds from your account on the day it is received or the first working day thereafter.

Special Education state aid is required by law to be deposited in the school district's general fund budget. The revenue would then be transferred from the general fund to the special education fund.

With your cursor, select Cell F3 (in red) and click on the arrow to scroll down and select the LEA number. The information will refresh when the LEA number is updated. Then select one of the tabs located at the bottom of the screen (Special Ed, Coop Split, Payment Received) to view each report. Out-of-District School Attendance and Transportation application must be resubmitted every year

K.S.A. 72-1046b allows a parent that resides 2.5 or more miles from the attendance center their child(ren) would attend to apply for attendance and transportation at another district. This application is given to the board of the receiving school district, requesting to attend school and be furnished transportation as a non-resident pupil. If the receiving board agrees to furnish transportation, it will be provided until the end of the school year.

Prior to providing transportation, the receiving district shall notify the school district of residence. This application must be signed by the parent and resubmitted every year.
