

LOW ENROLLMENT WEIGHTING THRESHOLD (FTE) (KSA 72-5149)



The Kansas School Equity and Enhancement Act (KSEEA), as enacted, includes a low enrollment weighting. The weighting applies to school districts with Full Time Equivalency (FTE) enrollments that are less than 1,622. The weighting is calculated on two linear transitions: for districts with 100 or fewer students the weighting is 101.4 percent of the enrollment of the district, and that amount transitions to approximately 3.5 percent of the enrollment of the district as the enrollment approaches 1,622 students. No amendments have been made to the low enrollment weighting since the enactment of the KSEEA.
