Driving Question: Is deep learning happening in your organization?


Purpose:

- Review protocols for collaboration across your organization
- Reflect and plan for intentional collaboration and learning opportunities

Sticky Note Clustering Protocol:

This activity allows you to personally reflect on the work happening in your building before organizing your ideas into bigger ideas based on group feedback.

- List all the capacity building/professional learning initiatives or programs that are in your school currently, and write the name of each initiative or program on a separate sticky note.
- 2. Assess each sticky note to determine the depth of the learning design and the degree of collaboration.



- 3. Place the sticky notes on the grid.
- 4. Discuss the following:
 - a. What current strategies/programs/initiatives are the most promising for developing collaborative culture and deep learning?
 - b. How might we make our approaches more collaborative/effective?



Sticky Note Clustering Protocol Organizer

Depth of Learning	Personal Growth	Sustained and Systemic
	Individual growth but with little connection to the organization.	Strong collaborative learning with sustained and system-wide impact.
	Surface Learning	Frustration
	Individual learning with little application to role.	Strong collaboration but with little impact on the organization.
	Degree of Collaborative Learning
