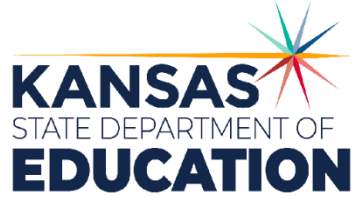
Purpose
