School Content Filters



- The Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA)
 - Schools must address:
 - Access by minors to inappropriate content
 - Safety and security of minors when using e-mail, chat rooms and other forms of direct electronic communications
 - Unauthorized access and other unlawful activities by minors online
 - Unauthorized disclosure, use, and dissemination of personal information regarding minors
 - Restricting access to harmful materials
